International Rights: Patenting outside the US


Does your invention have a market overseas? For most all products, the answer is a resounding YES! It's not always true for systems/methods/processes though, so it will be a case-by-case business decision. Here are the two major options:


- Filing Direct Foreign Applications: You may, within 12 months of your priority date, file directly with foreign country's patent offices, but you must coordinate this 3-4 months in advance to allow preparation/translation for timely submittal
- PCT: At the time of filing your NPA, you can file a <u>Patent Cooperation Treaty</u> (<u>PCT</u>) application (<u>timeline</u>), which will allow you the *ability* to file into <u>over a 150 member countries</u>. There is a parallel for design patents (see *Hague*)

Additional Considerations for International Filing


- Prepare to File: Your Bold Patent Attorney will prepare the application and be sure to claim priority back to any PPA that was filed
- Coordination with Foreign Patent Counsel: When it comes time to file in foreign countries, your Bold team will coordinate with foreign counsel to assure timely filing and prosecution of your patent filings
- Additional Cost/Opportunity: Along with the opportunity to have rights in several countries around the world, comes the cost to prosecute the patents, acquire them, and most of all *enforce them*. So plan accordingly.








PCT Basics: Key Dates Timeline

- PCT Network
- Bold & Foreign Attorney
- International Filing Strategy

30 Months: Deadline to File in Foreign Countries:

- Foreign Attorney(s)
- PCT Network
